Judi Love is one of the biggest names in British comedy. In 2024 she became the first Black British female comedian to headline and sell out the London Palladium, captured in her Amazon Prime Video special *The One Like Judi Love: Live*. She stars in *Last One Laughing UK*, has been a *Loose Women* regular since 2020, has interviewed Janet Jackson and Whoopi Goldberg, and was handpicked to open for Dave Chappelle on his UK arena dates. In 2026 she brings her live show to New York for two nights at the SoHo Playhouse, 6 and 7 November.

FULL BIOGRAPHY

Judi Love is one of the biggest names in British comedy: a stand-up, presenter, actor and writer known for sharp, unfiltered, real-life humor.

In 2024 she made history as the first Black British female comedian to headline and sell out the London Palladium. The show became her Amazon Prime Video special, *The One Like Judi Love: Live*, now streaming worldwide, and she also stars in Prime Video's global comedy hit *Last One Laughing UK*.

She's a regular on ITV's *Loose Women* (the UK's version of *The View*), which she joined in 2020, and has interviewed international icons including Janet Jackson and Whoopi Goldberg. She was also handpicked to open for Dave Chappelle on his UK arena dates, his only female support act.

On screen, she appears in the feature film *Girl Group*, written, directed by and starring Rebel Wilson of *Pitch Perfect*, which premiered at the Toronto International Film Festival with a cast including Jennifer Coolidge, Randall Park, Nicole Scherzinger and Sally Hawkins.

Her comedy is built on honesty. Love started out in 2011 with a show about caring for her mother through dementia, and made her name on warm, no-filter storytelling about parenting, work and the chaos of everyday life. Her current UK tour, *All About the Love*, follows a sold-out debut national run.

Off stage, she hosts the podcast *Our Table with Judi Love*, honest and funny conversations with guests from screen, music and stage.

Born in Hackney, East London, to a Jamaican family, Love holds a Master's in social work and, in 2025, received an Honorary Doctorate of Arts from the University of East London for her contribution to comedy, broadcasting and advocacy for underrepresented voices. She is a single mother of two.
